Koen Demyttenaere is Academic Chair of the University Psychiatric Centre KU Leuven, campus Gasthuisberg. He is full professor at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Leuven. His initial research interest was psychosomatic obstetrics and gynaecology (mainly stress and infertility), but his research area gradually shifted towards anxiety and depression. Main interest fields are compliance with antidepressants, conceptualisation of depression and anxiety, scales in anxiety and depression, quality of life, and epidemiology of anxiety and depression. He published more than 270 international papers (H-index 54). He is member of several international advisory boards in the field of antidepressants and frequently lectures abroad.


PROF. ROGER S. MCINTYRE



Roger McIntyre is Professor of Psychiatry and Pharmacology at the University of Toronto and Head of the Mood Disorders Psychopharmacology Unit at the University Health Network, Toronto. He is also Executive Director of the Brain and Cognition Discovery Foundation in Toronto, and director for the Depression and Bipolar Support Alliance from Chicago, USA. He has been named in 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017 as one of "The World's Most Influential Scientific Minds". He is involved in multiple research endeavours which primarily aim to characterize the association between mood disorders, notably cognitive function and medical comorbidity. He is extensively involved in medical education. He has contributed to the Florida Best Practice Psychotherapeutic Medication Guidelines for Adults with Major Depressive Disorder and Bipolar Disorder. He was the co-chair of the Canadian Network for Mood and Anxiety Treatments (CANMAT) Task Force on the Treatment of Comorbidity in Adults with Major Depressive Disorder or Bipolar Disorder. He has published more than 400 articles and has edited several textbooks on mood disorders.
